Acting Assistant Secretary of Defense, Logistics and Materiel Readiness,

I recommend approval of the attached "Request for Delegation of Authority to Transfer Foreign Excess Personal Property (FEPP) located in the Operation Observant Compass (OOC) Operations Area" memo, signed by Maj Gen Harrington on 3 January 2017.

This delegation memo allows USARAF the authority to transfer FEPP at Obo; Central African Republic, Nzara; South Sudan, Entebbe; Uganda; and Dungu; Democratic Republic of Congo. This memo facilitates the requirement for USARAF to return base camps to bare earth conditions by allowing the transfer of property to host nations, thereby saving the government funds by not redistributing or disposing of property. USARAF estimates that there are approximately 1,000 pieces of government furnished property located at these sites and the majority of this equipment provides life and logistical support at base camps.

Procedures for screening of FEPP will be adhered to based on current guidance and Department of Defense policies. Service components will be given an opportunity to request nominated FEPP equipment.
