MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Certificate of Mandatory COVID-19 Restriction of Movement (ROM)

References: a. DOD COVID-19 Task Force Memorandum “Testing and Reporting of DOD COVID-19 Screenings” Attachment 3 – Guidance for Reducing Risk of COVID-19 Transmission, 21 May 20
b. SECDEF Memorandum – “Assuring Allies and Partners Regarding U.S. Force Deployments in a Coronavirus Disease 2019 Environment, 06 Jul 20

1. The World Health Organization declared a Global Pandemic on 11 Mar 20. In response USAFRICOM has implemented force health protection measures. To reduce risk to force and mission, personnel traveling into the USAFRICOM AOR will complete a mandatory fourteen (14) day ROM (as defined in DoDI 6200.03 dated March 28, 2019) prior to departure for the AOR with reduced risk routing per the USAFRICOM Theater Entry Requirements. This memorandum, when endorsed by a General/Flag Officer/Senior Executive Service in the chain of command, or Contracting Officer, based on contracted services, approves travel of the deploying units or individuals providing forces to US Africa Command, and serves as a validation of mandatory ROM.

2. The below mentioned individual or group has attested to have met the following actions in accordance with USAFRICOM Theater Entry Requirements:

- 14 days ROM prior to departure for the AOR at a designated location at or nearby the point of embarkation.
- No general commercial travel (air, ground, rail, sea) was used after or during ROM.
- Medical Screening per SecDef Guidance.
- Practice social distancing wherever practical during transportation.
- Wear a face mask at all times during transit whenever practical.

Personnel in-transit understand that they will maintain ROM as they continue onward movement to final destination.

3. This completed and signed certificate verifies accomplishment of all COVID-19 Theater Entry Requirements, authorized approving official certification for CONUS/OCONUS ROM and Group Leader certification during transportation. It will be presented to air terminal operations at the port of disembarkation to gain access to Theater. If personnel or groups arrive without this certificate they will be subject to 14-day ROM at their theater entry point before moving into Theater.
